Nightingale herself wandered the wards at night, providing support to the patients; this earned her the title of "Lady with the Lamp." She gained the respect of the soldiers and medical establishment alike. Nightingale's strenuous efforts during Crimean war influenced her to establish nursing as a profession. She pioneered the concept of education for nurses and influenced the nursing education to a great extent.
